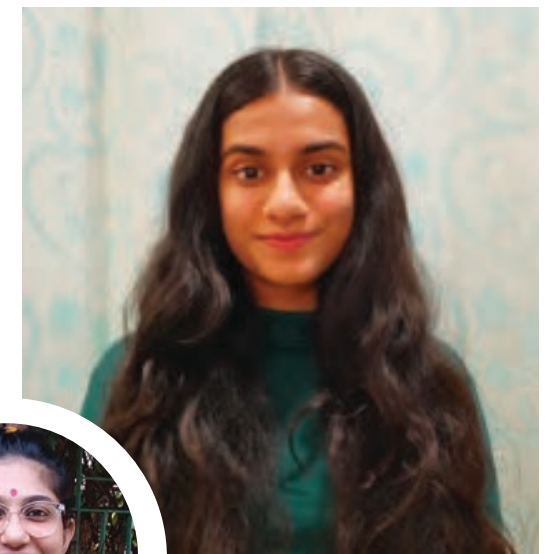

SELF, NO-SELF AND SELF-CONSCIOUSNESS: SOME CLASSICAL INDIAN VIEWS

Have you ever wondered how physical, emotional, and mental transformation affects one's sense of self?

The opinions expressed regarding the nature of subjectivity and self-awareness in classical Indian thinking have several themes that are relevant to this one. Another is yoga practise and enlightenment.

Prof Jain in conversation with Prof. Phillips talked about Vedānta, Yogācāra Buddhism, Nyāya, Cārvāka, and other classical views, in particular the debate between Naiyāyikas and Buddhists.

RASA IN MORAL JOURNEY- AESTHETIC DIMENSIONS OF ETHICAL ACTION IN GANDHI

At the conclusion of his autobiography, Mahatma Gandhi states that his "Experiments with Truth" served as a source of rasa (aesthetic delight). Does Mahatma Gandhi's belief in "ethical activities as things of beauty and avenues to reach perfect harmony" have any additional evidence to support it?

Prof. Jain and Prof. Bhatt talked on how Mahatma Gandhi's works show a quest for the harmony of goodness, truth, and beauty.

ALTERNATIVE ONTOLOGIES AND EPISTEMOLOGIES: IS THERE AN INDIAN WAY OF KNOWING AND THEORIZING IN SOCIAL SCIENCE?

In this webinar, Prof. Kumar made his case for context-dependent pluralism in ontologies and epistemologies. Using Dhandak and Jan Andolan as examples, he demonstrated the possibility of alternative theorization of protest cultures from an Indian context and history, but with the potential for context-free universal explanatory power.

THE UNENDING UKRAINE CRISES: ARE THERE ANY WINNERS?

Russia's war against Ukraine has unleashed several ripples in international affairs due to the unprecedented weaponization of financial instruments and the information space. What could be the possible scenario in the aftermath of this crisis?

Prof. Liu engaged in an interactive session with Nandan Unnikrishnan, Distinguished Fellow at ORF to trace the origins of Russia-Ukraine/Europe US hostilities and examine the possible emerging scenarios, and how the 21st-century geopolitics and geoeconomics will realign in the aftermath of this crisis.

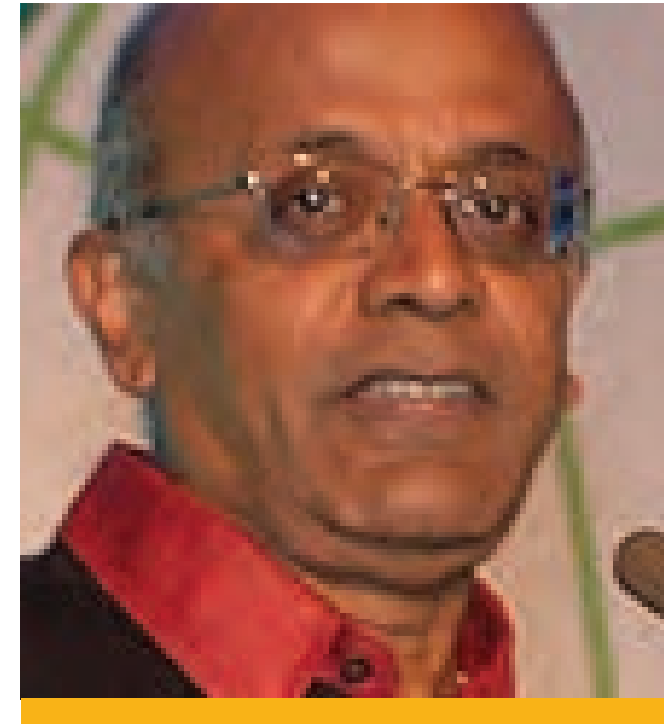
IC3 - THEORY TO PRACTICE (SGD TO SDG) INCORPORATING SUSTAINABILITY IN COUNSELING

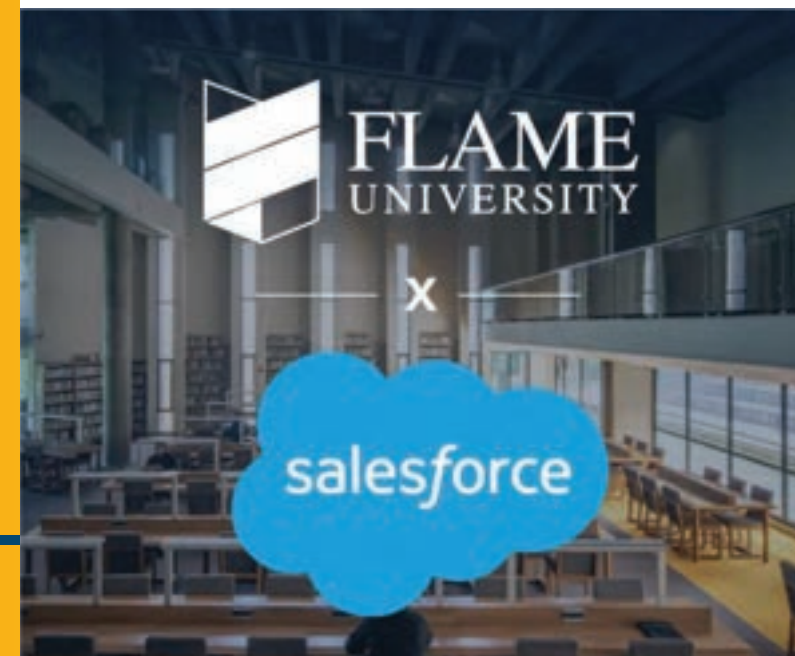
