# **PROGRAM DETAILS**

After hosting multiple programs and FIL alumni meets that covered topics like valuation, accounting shenanigans, investment checklists, mental heuristics and negotiation amongst others, FIL is planning another program, 'FLAME Investment Lab –Value Investing Blueprint'.

This program on 'Value Investing Blueprint' will be spread over seven Sundays in a twelve-week window, and will include lessons on:

- · Practical, time-tested ideas in value investing
- Identifying competitive moats and analyzing specific sectors to help you build your circle of competence.
- Psychology of investing and building a latticework of mental models to make better investment decisions.
- Analyzing financial statements.
- Estimating intrinsic values.
- Creating a portfolio of high-quality businesses.

This program is designed to provide a framework for investment decision making. It is not about technicals or quantitative models. There will be no stock recommendations. Self-study during the week, in between the class sessions, will be expected. This self-learning will be guided by a recommended list of books to be read. Participants will be able to borrow these books from the FLAME Vivekananda Library.

By the end of this program, you will be able to judge whether being a value investor is the right career path for you. At the very least, you will know what qualities to seek in your financial advisor. Value investing is a journey. It can't be learnt in twelve weeks or even a few years. As Warren Buffett has said, "It is extraordinary to me that the idea of buying dollar bills for 40 cents takes immediately with people or it doesn't take at all. It's like an inoculation. If it doesn't grab a person right away, I find you can talk to him for years and show him records, and it doesn't make any difference."

Please note that there will be an optional test at the end of the program. A certificate will be awarded to all participants who clear the test.

# **FACILITIES & INFRASTRUCTURE**
