### FLAME signs MoU with the London Metropolitan University.

We have recently signed the Memorandum of Understanding with London Metropolitan University, U.K. This memorandum describes an intention to collaborate on educational projects between FLAME and London Metropolitan University. Both institutions will encourage direct contact and cooperation between their academic staff, departments, institutes and other research centers subject to the provisions of this memorandum.

Areas of cooperation are envisaged initially to include the arts, humanities, leadership and management. Both universities have also agreed to commit resources, both human and financial, to develop the above activities and to seek external funding for the same. Other areas for collaboration may be mutually identified in the future and cooperative projects related to them may be developed mutually between both the parties of this Memorandum in the spirit of institutional friendship and cultural, educational and Scientific Cooperation.

London Metropolitan University was created on 1 August 2002 by the merger of London Guildhall University (now London City campus) and the University of North London (now London North campus). Prior to the merger both institutions had long histories dating back to 1848 of providing quality education in the City and north and east London. London Met is the largest single University in London and one of the largest Universities in the UK with over 37,000 students and with buildings spread throughout the centre of London.

London Metropolitan University is one of the foremost providers of undergraduate, postgraduate, professional and vocational education and training in Britain. Its courses are planned in consultation with employers and examining bodies in commerce, industry, the world of art and design, the financial services industries and the professions.
