

## Scholarships at FLAME

There are three kind of scholarships at FLAME. These are:

1. **Merit cum Means:** This is given at the time of admission to any of the courses at FLAME. It is awarded on the basis of the student's academic record and the income strata that they belong to. The amount of scholarship varies depending on the income strata. However, the scholarship does not cover the living expenses. The scholarship amount will be adjusted equally across all the trimesters. For an under graduate the scholarship amount will be divided into 12 installments and adjusted against the respective trimester fees.

The scholarship is awarded for the full duration of the program – two years in the case of the post graduate program and four years in the case of the under graduate program.

The continuation of the scholarship is dependent on the awardees maintaining a CGPA of 8.0. In case, they fail to meet this norm, they will be placed on "Academic Probation" and their scholarship status will be reviewed every trimester.

2. **Merit:** Merit scholarships are for the first academic year only. This is given on the basis of their academic record before joining FLAME.
3. **Dean's Roll of Honor:** This is awarded on the basis of the student's performance in the previous academic year. Each school declares a Dean's Roll of Honor and Merit Scholarships will be given to all those in the Roll of Honor. The amount of scholarships is given below.
  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> Rank Rs 1,00,000/-
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> Rank Rs 40,000/- each
  - c. 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> Rank Rs 20,000/- each

Such merit Scholarships will be given by the 1<sup>st</sup> Trimester of the next academic year provided the student has not had infringements in campus or in academics. The term in which the infringement has occurred and the punishment has been completed by the student are the terms in which the student will not be entitled to listing in the Dean's Roll of Honour or merit scholarships for such terms alone. The Dean shall reserve the rights to hold back any merit Scholarship at his/her discretion. The amount will deducted from the next payment due for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Trimester of the next academic year.

**In case a scholarship student withdraws from the programme, the student has to refund the scholarship amount that the Foundation has already disbursed.**

The scholarship committee reviews the Scholarships from time to time and reserves the right to alter, modify change or withdraw any of the above provisions and policies.

### **Annexure**

We have a policy of allowing a 5 % discount on the tuition fees component of the total fees if all the fees is paid in one single installment at the beginning of the academic year before the due date.

This discount will not be available to those students who have been granted merit-cum-means scholarships. But it will be available to those students who have been awarded merit scholarships.
