

FLAME University Fee Refund Policy on Withdrawal of Admission

Incoming Class of 2026

- Enrolment Deposit
 - i) Refund of enrolment deposit shall be considered in accordance with the terms of the admission offer letter.

- Program, Lodging, Boarding and Other Fees
 - i) In the event that an offer of admission is withdrawn or FLAME University is unable to provide the program, all such fees are fully refundable, unless the offer was made on the basis of incorrect or incomplete information supplied by the student.
 - ii) If a student withdraws his/her admission for any reason, fees shall be refunded as below:

S.No.	Date of Withdrawal Request	Percentage of Refund of Fees *
a.	If a request for withdrawal is received upto July 15, 2026	100%
b.	If a request for withdrawal is received after July 15, 2026, but up to July 31, 2026	90%
c.	If a request for withdrawal is received after July 31, 2026, but up to August 15, 2026	80 %
d.	If a request for withdrawal is received after August 15, 2026, but up to August 31, 2026	50 %
e.	If a request for withdrawal is received after August 31, 2026	00 %

** In case of (a) in the above table, the entire fee paid shall be refunded after making a deduction of Rs.5,000/- as processing charges.*

Notes:

- Refund percentage is exclusive of caution money paid.
- Refund details are subject to the payments made by the prescribed deadlines only.
- Where a scholarship has been granted, the refund, if any, shall be computed on the full semester/year fee prescribed for the program, and not on the fee amount after deduction or adjustment of the scholarship.

- A student who fails to meet program progression rules and who is thus not permitted to re-enroll will be eligible for refund of the respective semester program fees, if paid in advance of notification of exclusion.
- In exceptional circumstances, and where acceptable documentary evidence can be provided, a student may be considered for a higher refund than the one mentioned above. Exceptional circumstances include illness or disability, death of the student or a close family member (parent, sibling, spouse or child), or natural calamity.
- No refund request shall be admissible in case the admission is cancelled/withdrawn due to non-fulfillment of the minimum eligibility requirement or non-submission of mandatory documents by the prescribed last date or if the admission has been secured on the basis of fictitious information and/or forged documents.
