Saurabh Madaan is the Founder and Managing Member of Manveen Asset Management, which focuses on long-term equity investments. Prior to founding Manveen, Saurabh was the Deputy Chief Investment Officer at Markel Corporation in Virginia. He was previously a Senior Data Scientist at the Google HQ in Mountain View, California. Saurabh is also Adjunct Faculty – Finance at FLAME University. WHAT NOT TO EXPECT?

SELECTION CRITERIA

Candidates who aspire to be in a successful leadership management role in an organization. The program is highly recommended for candidates who have mid management level of experience in managing family business or who are likely to be in a leadership role in the near future.

This course is also for NGO leaders, group leaders, entrepreneurs and founders in a growing organization.

- INR 40,000 plus GST (INR 47,200) which includes tuition, course materials, meals and on campus accommodation.

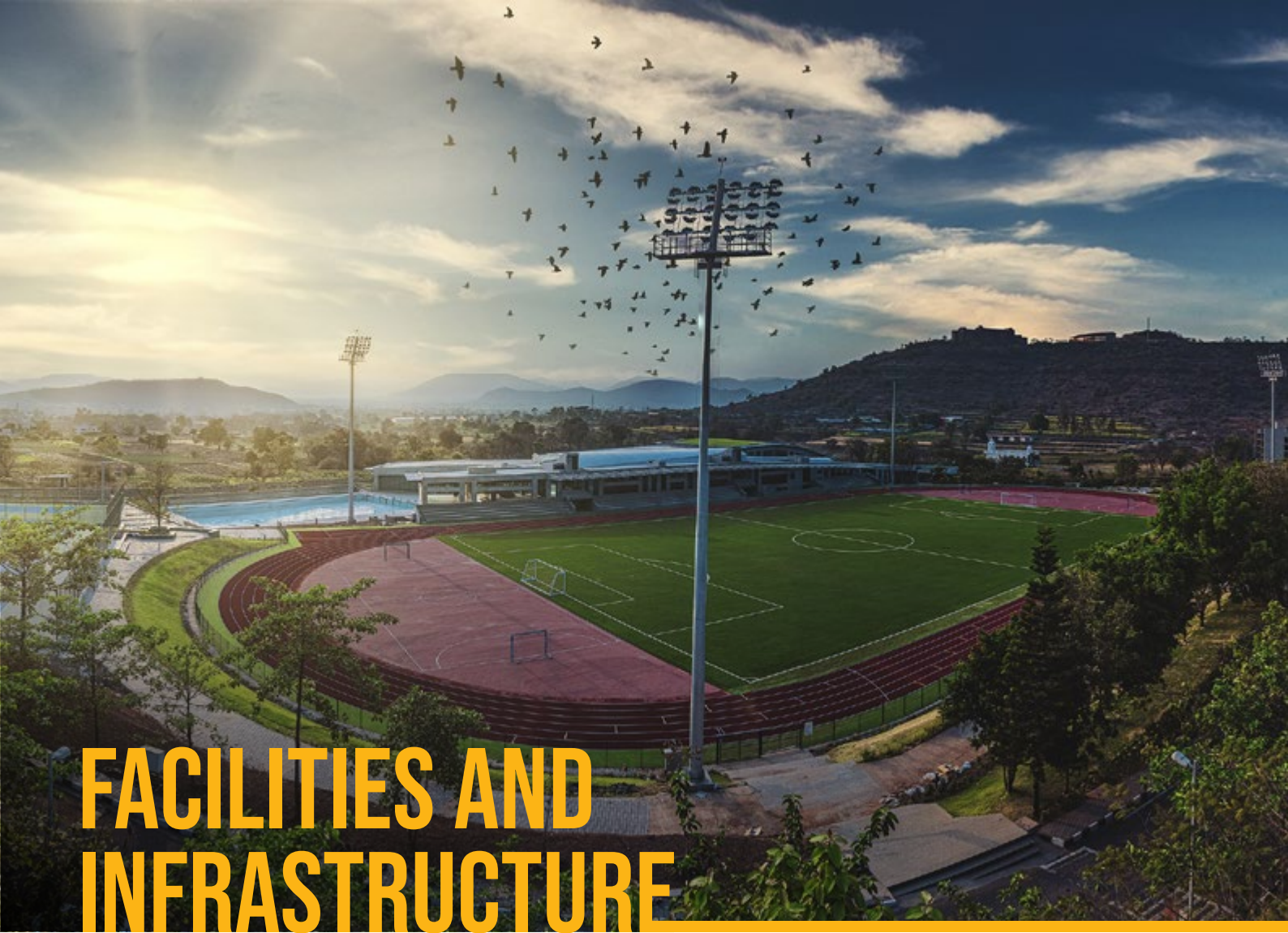

FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE

FLAME offers 60 acres of tranquil space, just 13 kms. from the Pune University main gate. It is an eco-friendly campus adjoining a 18-hole golf course.
