



ABOUT THE FLAME INVESTMENT LAB




SPEAKER

SANJAY BAKSHI

Sanjay Bakshi is a Distinguished Adjunct Professor - Finance at FLAME University. Previously he was Adjunct Professor at Management Development Institute, Gurgaon. Sanjay has twenty-five years of teaching experience. He is also a Managing Partner at ValueQuest Capital LLP, a SEBI Registered Investment Adviser.

Sanjay received M.Sc. (Economics) from London School of Economics and Political Science and B.Com. (Hons.) from University of Delhi. He is also a Fellow member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

Sanjay is 59 years old and lives in New Delhi with his wife and two daughters.





This program will use a case-based approach to teach key concepts in business and investment analysis, including the following:

- 1. Fundamental attributes of good, bad and ugly business models
- 2. Fragility, robustness, and anti-fragility
- 3. Incorporating Michael Porter's framework in analysing various business models
- 4. Using Philip Fisher's framework for identifying high-quality businesses
- 5. Warren Buffett's owner-earnings framework for business as well as investment analysis
- 6. Benjamin Graham's frameworks in value investing (bargain securities, debt-capacity bargains, dividend-related themes)

- 7. Combining Philip Fisher and Ben Graham's approaches in the value investing process
- 8. Evaluating operating and capital allocation skills of business managers
- 9. Bayesian reasoning in investment decisions
- 10. Dividend policy, share buybacks, share issuances
- 11. Applications of the pari-mutuel nature of stock markets and industries
- 12. Mean reversion vs. fundamental momentum
- 13. Business models of low-cost business model, pricing power, and platforms

Through various case studies, participants will learn about one or more critical business and investment analysis aspects. They will then work towards discovering similar situations, often in different industries. These cases will serve as stepping stones for generating more creative ideas for business and investment analysts. Many of the cases that will be covered in the program were developed by the Instructor based on his experience as a practising value investor over the last thirty-one years.

- Selection decisions will take into account the responses submitted in the application form.

PROGRAM FFFS
