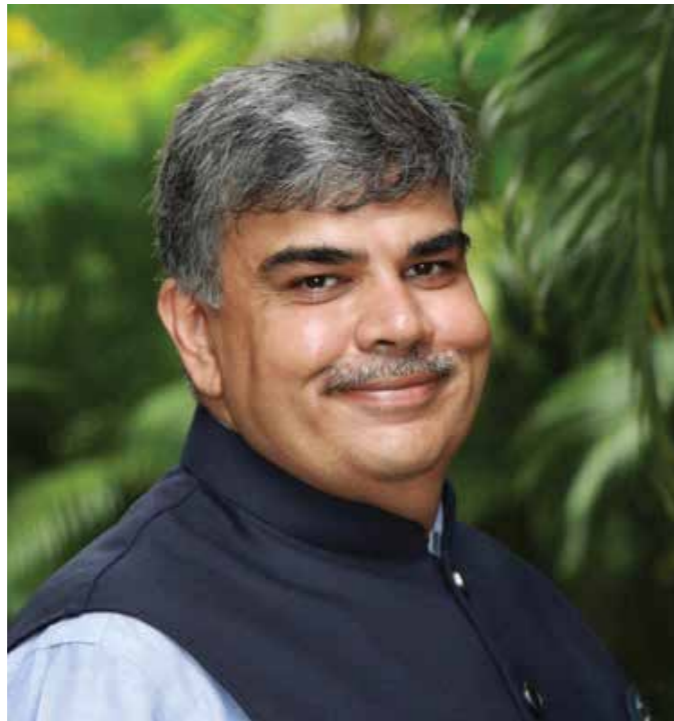

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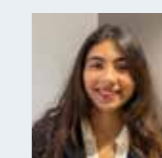

FLAME University partnered with the International Union of Biological Sciences (IUBS) to create a global network of environmentally conscious educators. The Centre for Sustainability, Environmental and Climate Change (CSECC) at FLAME University will provide over 800 scientifically vetted resources, a repository of over 370 lesson plans and more than 530 teaching tools across 10 disciplines.

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
