At the conclusion of his autobiography, Mahatma Gandhi states that his "Experiments with Truth" served as a source of rasa (aesthetic delight). Does Mahatma Gandhi's belief in "ethical activities as things of beauty and avenues to reach perfect harmony" have any additional evidence to support it?

Prof. Jain and Prof. Bhatt talked on how Mahatma Gandhi's works show a quest for the harmony of goodness, truth, and beauty.

QUANTIFYING SMALL AREA VARIATIONS FOR PRECISIONS-INVIGORATED GLOBAL HEALTH RESEARCH AND PRACTICE

There has been a great interest in disaggregated data on population health and well-being at subnational levels when it comes to global health, but such efforts have largely been confined to macro-geographies.

Prof. Kim through this webinar organized by the FLAME Center for Economics & Public Policy and the Department of Economics, presented evidence from empirical analyses illustrating substantial small area variation across the different health and development outcomes in India and their implications for micro-level geo-targeting for more precise, efficient, and equitable allocation of global health resources.
